



Our Project Progress

- Sheringham Shoal operational since 20 12, Dudgeon since 20 17
- 2020 Agreement for Lease to extend the existing wind farms
- Development Consent Application (DCO) for both SEP and DEP submitted September 2022
- Secretary of State granted the consent decision on 17 April 20 24
- Industry first in UK for two offshore wind projects under separate ownership being granted consent under a shared application
 - Includes an option to utilise an integrated transmission system development selected as a Pathfinder Project for coordinated offshore transmission by the UK Government



O&M Campaign for Current Assets

- Planned, preventative and corrective maintenance at both Sheringham Shoal and Dudgeon wind farms
- 3 campaigns using jack up vessels, in addition to scheduled maintenance programme
- 16 major components exchanged requiring support from specialist contractors
- Strong focus on the local supply chain in Norfolk and Suffolk, including:
 - Vessels: Tidal Transit and Seajacks
 - Inspection Services: Certex and Stowen
 - Motor and Generator Repair Services: Yarmouth Rewinds


