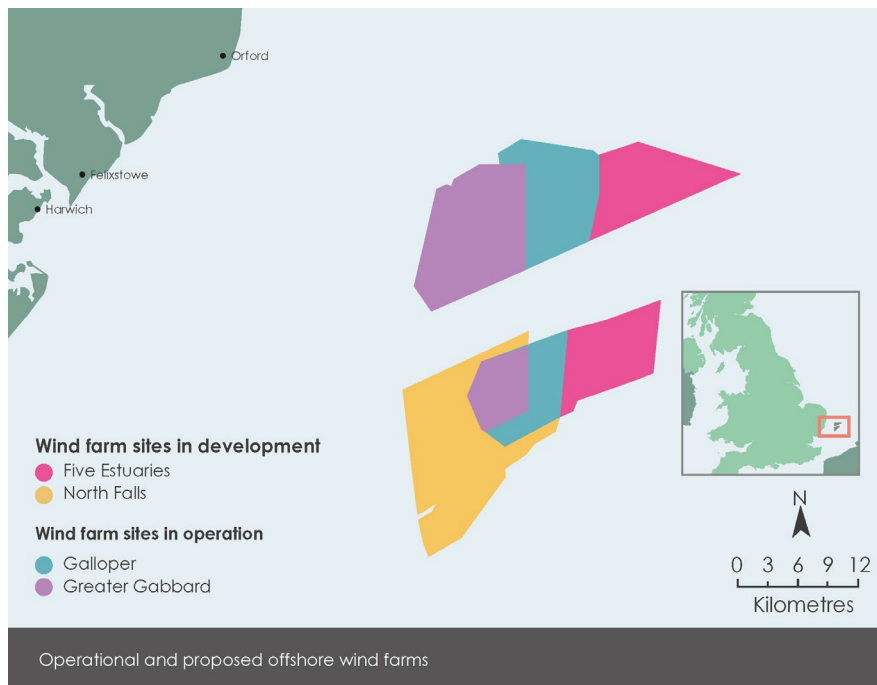

Proposed extension to the operational Galloper Wind Farm.



Located off the north Essex / south Suffolk coast. 37km closest distance to shore.



Up to 79 turbines with a maximum tip height of 370m. Split across two seabed areas covering 128km².



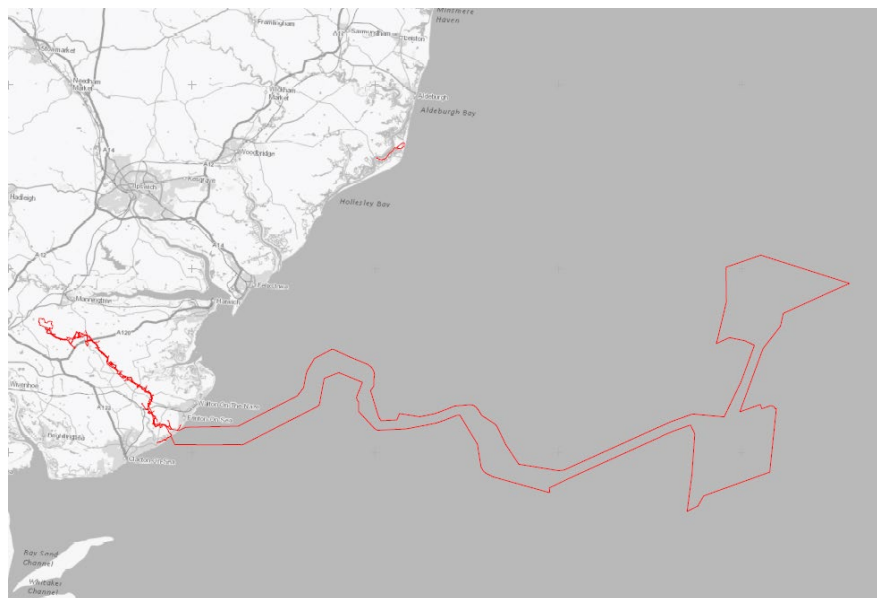
One new onshore substation to connect the project to the proposed National Grid East Anglia Connection substation.



Would power hundreds of thousands UK households each year.




RWE is leading the development on behalf of the project partners, which also include a Macquarie-led consortium, ESB and Sumitomo Corporation. RWE is leading the development.
