Key Milestones

- 1979 Development & delivery of HUET/Drill Tank Training RGI
- 1984 –1800 North Sea workers completed a 5 day basic survival & safety course.
- 1985 Petans Norwich opened a Helipad & simulated helideck fire fighting. A cold dip in the North Sea and Fire Fighting in Norwich.
- 1988 Piper Alpha Disaster, Lord Cullen Report (1990).
- Sept 1995 –Horsham St Faith Site fully developed to enable the full Survival (BOSIET) delivery on one site.
- October 2016 GWO Accreditation Basic Training for those working on Wind Turbines Offshore
